

PRIVACY POLICY

I. INFORMATION RELATED TO THE PRIVACY POLICY OF THE SITE

1. This section contains information on the management methods of Italy Crowd with reference to the processing of data of Italy Crowd users.
2. This policy is also valid for the purposes of Article 13 of the Regulation (EU) no. 2016/679, concerning the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data as well as the free circulation of such data, for those who interact with Italy Crowd and can be reached at the address corresponding to the home page:

www.italy-crowd.com
3. The policy is intended only for Italy Crowd and not for other websites that may be consulted by the user through links contained therein.
4. The purpose of this document is to provide information on the methods, timing and nature of the information that the data controllers must provide to users when connecting to the Italy Crowd web pages, regardless of the purpose of the connection itself, according to the Italian and European legislation.
5. The policy may undergo changes due to the introduction of new rules in this regard, therefore the user is invited to periodically check this page.
6. If the user is under the age of 14, pursuant to art. 8, c.1 regulation (EU) 2016/679, and to Art. 2 - Quinquies of Legislative Decree 196/2003, as amended by Legislative Decree 181/18, must legitimize his consent through the authorization of his parents or guardians.

II. DATA PROCESSING

1- Data Controller

1. The data controller is the natural or legal person, public authority, service or other body which, individually or together with others, determines the purposes and means of the processing of personal data. He also deals with safety profiles.

2- Data Processor

1. The data processor is the natural or legal person, public authority, service or other body that processes personal data on behalf of the data controller.
2. Pursuant to Article 28 of Regulation (EU) no. 2016/679, upon the appointment of the data controller, the data processor of the Italy Crowd website is: Augusto Vecchi.

3- Place of data processing

1. The processing of data generated by the use of Italy Crowd takes place at Viale Italia 343, 19125 La Spezia.
2. If necessary, the data connected to the newsletter service can be processed by the data processor or by subjects appointed by him for this purpose at the designated office.

III. COOKIES

1- Types of cookies

1. The Italy Crowd site uses cookies to make the user's browsing experience easier and more intuitive: cookies are small text strings used to store some information that may concern the user, his preferences or the access device to the Internet (computer, tablet or mobile phone) and are mainly used to adapt the operation of the site to the user's expectations, offering a more personalized browsing experience and memorizing the choices made previously.
2. A cookie consists of a reduced set of data transferred to the user's browser from a web server and can only be read by the server that made the transfer. It is not an executable code and does not transmit viruses.
3. Cookies do not record any personal information and any data identifiable will not be stored. If one wishes, it is possible to prevent the saving of some or all cookies. However, in this case the use of the site and the services offered could be compromised. To proceed without changing the options relating to cookies, simply continue browsing.

Below, the different types of cookies the site uses:

2- Technical cookies

1. There are numerous technologies used to store information on the user's computer, which are then collected by the sites. Among these, the best known and most used is that of HTML cookies. They are used for navigation and to facilitate the access and the use of the site by the users. They are necessary for the transmission of communications on the electronic network, hence for the supplier to provide the service requested by the customer.
2. The settings to manage or disable cookies may vary depending on the internet browser used. In any case, the user can manage or request the general deactivation or cancellation of cookies by changing the settings of his internet browser. That deactivation may slow down or prevent access to some parts of the site.
3. The use of technical cookies allows for a safe and efficient use of the site.
4. The cookies that are entered in the browser and retransmitted through Google Analytics or through the blogger statistics service or similar are technical only if used for the purpose of optimizing the site directly by the owner of the site, who can collect information in aggregate form on the number of users and on how they visit the site. Under these conditions, the same rules in terms of information and consent provided for technical cookies apply to analytics cookies.
5. From the point of view of duration, it is possible to distinguish between temporary session cookies, which are automatically deleted at the end of the browsing session and are used to identify the user and therefore avoid logging into each page visited, and permanent ones, that remain active on the PC until expiry or cancellation by the user.
6. Session cookies may be installed in order to allow access and stay in the reserved area of the portal as an authenticated user.
7. They are not stored permanently but only for the duration of the navigation until the browser is closed and disappear when the latter is closed. Their use is strictly limited to the transmission of session identifiers, consisting of random numbers generated by the server necessary to allow the safe and efficient exploration of the site.

IV- DATA TREATED

1- Data processing method

1. Like all websites, this site also makes use of log files, in which the information collected during user visits are stored in an automated manner. The information collected could be the following:
 - internet protocol address (IP);
 - type of browser and device parameters used to connect to the site;
 - name of the internet service provider (ISP);
 - date and time of visit;
 - web page of origin of the visitor (referral) and exit;

- possibly the number of clicks.

2. The aforementioned information is processed in an automated form and collected in an exclusively aggregated form in order to verify the correct functioning of the site, and for security reasons. This information will be treated on the basis of the legitimate interests of the owner.
3. For security purposes (spam filters, firewalls, virus detection), the automatically recorded data may also include personal data such as the IP address, which could be used, in compliance with the applicable laws, in order to block attempts to damage the site itself or other users, or in any case to block harmful activities or constituting a crime. These data are never used for the identification or profiling of the user, but only for the purpose of protecting the site and its users, such information will be treated on the basis of the legitimate interests of the owner.
4. If the site allows the insertion of comments, or in the case of specific services requested by the user, including the possibility of sending the Curriculum Vitae for a possible working relationship, the site automatically detects and records some identification data of the user, including the email address. These data are voluntarily provided by the user at the time of the request to provide the service. By inserting a comment or other information, the user expressly accepts the privacy policy, and, in particular, agrees that the contents inserted are freely to be disseminated to third parties. The data received will be used exclusively for the provision of the requested service and only for the time necessary for the provision of the service.
5. The information that users of the site will deem to make public through the services and tools made available by them, are provided by the user knowingly and voluntarily, exempting this site from any responsibility for any violations of the laws. It is up to the user to verify that they have permission to enter personal data of third parties or content protected by national and international regulations.

2- Purpose of data processing

1. The data collected by the site during its functioning are used exclusively for the purposes indicated above and kept for the time strictly necessary to carry out the activities specified, and in any case no later than 5 years.
2. In any case, the data collected from the site will never be provided to third parties, for any reason, unless it is a legitimate request by the judicial authority and only in the cases provided for by law.
3. The data used for security purposes (blocking attempts to damage the site) are kept for the time strictly necessary to achieve the previously indicated purpose.

3- Data provided by the user

1. As indicated above, the optional, explicit and voluntary sending of e-mails to the addresses indicated on this site entails the subsequent acquisition of the sender's address, necessary to respond to requests, as well as any other personal data included in the message.
2. Specific summary information will be progressively reported or displayed on the pages of the site set up for particular services on request.

4- Support in configuring the browser

1. The user can also manage cookies through the settings of his browser. However, deleting the cookies from the browser could remove the preferences set for the site.

V- USER'S RIGHTS

1. Art. 13, c. 2 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 lists the user's rights.
2. The Italy Crowd website therefore intends to inform the user about the existence of the user's rights, based on the following articles of Regulation (EU) 2016/679:
 - a) Based on art. 15, of the right of the interested party to ask the owner for access to personal data, based on art. 16 the possibility of rectifying the data provided, based on article 18 the possibility of integrating or limiting the processing concerning himself, or to oppose, for legitimate reasons, their treatment based on art. 21, in addition to the right to data portability based on art. 20 Regulation (EU);
 - b) the right to request cancellation based on Article 17, transformation into anonymous form or blocking of data processed in violation of the law, including those that do not need to be kept for the purposes for which the data have been collected or subsequently processed.

- c) the right to obtain the attestation that the updating, rectification, data integration, cancellation, data blocking, transformation operations have been brought to the attention, also as regards their content, of those to whom the data have been communicated or disseminated, except in the case in which this fulfillment proves impossible or involves the use of means manifestly disproportionate to the protected right.
3. Requests can be addressed to the data controller, without formalities or, alternatively, using the model provided by the Guarantor for the Protection of Personal Data, or by sending an email to: ceo@italy-crowd.com
4. If the treatment is based on art. 6, paragraph 1, letter. a) – consent expressed for use - or on art. 9, paragraph 2 letter. a) - express consent to the use of genetic, biometric, health-related data, revealing religious or philosophical beliefs or trade union membership, revealing racial or ethnic origin, political opinions - the user has the right to revoke consent at any time without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent given before the revocation.
5. Likewise, in case of violation of the law, the user has the right to lodge a complaint with the Guarantor for the Protection of Personal Data, as the authority responsible for monitoring the processing in the Italian State.

VI- TRANSFER OF DATA TO NON-EU COUNTRIES

1. This site may share some of the data collected with services located outside the European Union area. In particular with Google, Facebook and Microsoft (LinkedIn) through social plugins and the Google Analytics service. The transfer is authorized and strictly regulated by article 45, paragraph 1 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679, for which no further consent is required. The companies mentioned above guarantee their adherence to the Privacy Shield.
2. Data will never be transferred to third countries that do not comply with the conditions set out in article 45 et seq, of the (EU) Regulation.

VII- SECURITY OF THE DATA PROVIDED

1. This site processes user data in a lawful and correct manner, adopting appropriate security measures to prevent unauthorized access, disclosure, modification or unauthorized destruction of data. The processing is carried out using IT and / or telematic tools, with organizational methods and with logic strictly related to the purposes indicated.
2. In addition to the owner, in some cases, categories of employees involved in the organization of the site (administrative, commercial, marketing, legal, system administrators) or external subjects (such

as suppliers of third party technical services, postal couriers, hosting providers, IT companies, communication agencies) may have access to some data.
